2) What are the general rules relating to burden of proof? Decide, with reasons, upon who does the burden of proof lie in the following fact situations?

(a) Bell is accused of theft in a jewellery shop and Den of receiving stolen property. Both are being tried jointly. Bell wants the court to believe that he was elsewhere on the date and time of theft. Den wants the court to believe that he had no knowledge that he jewellery was stolen.

(b) 'A' (27yrs) a married woman died in gas cylinder blast after 4 years of marriage and death was not natural death. In Postmortum injury marks found in her back and legs. But soon before her death husband and his relatives tortured her for car from her parents , parents of 'A' have also deposed that 'A' was subjected to cruelty at her husbands house.
