There are various information systems used in the organization. Enterprise Resource Planning systems(ERP)-Introduced by research and analysis firm GARTNER in 1990. It is an Integrated computer-based system used to manage internal and external resources, including tangible assets, financial resources, materials, and human resources. Supply Chain Management systems (SCM) -It is the management of a network of interconnected businesses involved in the ultimate provision of product and service packages required by end customers. Customer Relationship Management Systems (CRM)-It is a broadly recognized, widely-implemented strategy for managing and nurturing a company's interactions with customers, clients and sales prospects. Product Lifecycle Management systems (PLM)-It is the process of managing the entire lifecycle of a product from its conception, through design and manufacture, to service and disposal. Knowledge is a strategic resource for any organization. We can define knowledge as 'information plus know-how'. Information alone is not enough to produce knowledge; we must also understand the best way to use information to solve a problem, contribute to a product or service or make a similar contribution to the organization. Knowledge builds over time in the heads of employees in the form of past decisions, processes in the organization, characteristics of products, interests of Customers and similar experiences. There are different types of knowledge. Nonaka distinguishes Between explicit and tacit knowledge. Explicit knowledge is represented by facts. Tacit knowledge is something we understand but have difficulty explaining. A good example is the ability to ride a bicycle. Many people can ride a bicycle, but it is very hard to explain in words to someone how to master this skill. Wisdom is the application of intelligence and experience toward the attainment of a common good. The knowledge and experience needed to make sensible decisions and judgments, or the good sense shown by the decisions and judgments made is wisdom. It is accumulated knowledge of life or in a particular sphere of activity that has been gained through experience. It is an opinion that almost everyone seems to share or express. Wisdom may also be in the form of ancient teachings or sayings.
