Q. 4. Answer the following questions. (10)

A) A son inherits a substantial debt left behind by his father, who borrowed money to perform a lavish wedding ceremony. At the same time, the son's mother claims a portion of her *Stridhan*, which was used by the father during his lifetime.

Question:

Examine the legal obligations of the son to repay the father's debt under the doctrine of Pious Obligation. Can the mother claim her *Stridhan*? Justify your answer with legal provisions and case laws.

B) A Muslim man dies intestate, leaving behind his wife, one son, two daughters, and a charitable Waqf he created during his lifetime. The son claims a larger share of the property than the daughters, and the wife asserts her right to a fixed portion. Question: Determine the distribution of the deceased's property according to Muslim Law of Succession. Additionally, discuss the rights of the heirs concerning the Waqf property.
