A) The *Hussainara Khatoon v. State of Bihar* case (1979) filed to address the plight of undertrial prisoners in Bihar who were languishing in jails for periods longer than the maximum sentences for their alleged offenses. Filed by activist lawyers, the case led the Supreme Court to recognize the right to a speedy trial as part of the fundamental right to life and personal liberty under Article 21 of the Constitution. This ruling triggered extensive judicial and legislative reforms, emphasizing the need for timely justice and better

conditions for undertrial detainees.
